**CHILDREN'S BURN FOUNDATION** provides medical, social and psychological services to children who have suffered severe burn injuries. From life-changing surgeries to specialized, often long-term care, physical therapy and support programs, CBF provides care that meets the full recovery needs of child burn survivors. Our burn prevention and education programs reach over 71,000 Los Angeles children, parents and caregivers every year. We have developed medical partnerships with centers of excellence in countries where there is strong in-reach into the health and education systems including Nigeria, Nicaragua, China, India, Israel, Ukraine and Pakistan, so that child burn survivors can be treated closer to their homes whenever possible. CBF has provided funds for the purchase of medical supplies and equipment for burn centers in these countries to help to provide more advanced burn care, and has acquired in-kind donations to help achieve better surgical results including artificial skin, wound care products, medical equipment and supplies. We will continue to expand burn prevention education with our medical partnerships in Ukraine, Pakistan and some Syrian refugee communities.
